

IGSA Financial Aid Process Document

Below are the two options that are available for Financial Aid in the IGSA system. Please review the options below and then complete the Financial Aid Form that is available on the IGSA website. Once the form is complete, e-mail it to the IGSA Player Agent for review. The e-mail address for the Player Agent can be found on the IGSA website.

Option 1: Payment Plan

- 1. The player is an existing IGSA player, or a new 6u Player.
- 2. Players who return from High School to play Fall Ball are eligible for this program.
- 3. League fees can be split into 3 payments that comprise the total fee for the season.
- 4. The first payment is due prior to the start of the first practice. The second payment will be due prior to the start of game play. The final payment will be due one month later.
- 5. Completion of the IGSA Financial Aid Form is required to be eligible for a payment plan.
- 6. A completed Financial Aid Form must be turned in prior to the formation of teams.
- 7. Approval of the Treasurer and Player Agent will be required for any payment plan.
- 8. Should the payment plan not be kept current:
 - a. The payment plan is ended and payment of the remaining balance is due
 - b. The player will not be allowed to continue on their team until payment is made in full

Option 2: Financial Assistance

- 1. The player is an existing IGSA player, or a new 6u Player.
- 2. Players who return from High School to play Fall Ball are **NOT** eligible for this program.
- 3. You must be in good financial standing with the league before any financial assistance will be granted.
- 4. There is a minimum league fee of \$100 per player required for any season. Should an additional reduction be needed, it will be reviewed on a case by case basis.
- 5. Completion of the IGSA Financial Aid Form is required to be eligible for any reduced fee.
- 6. Completed Financial Aid Form must be turned in prior to the formation of teams.
- 7. Approval of the Executive Board will be required for the \$100 reduced fee and any additional fee reductions beyond that.
- 8. When accepting financial assistance you agree to assist the league in any, and all, volunteer activities as called upon. This is not limited to being a coach of a team.
- 9. Payment of the reduced fee must be made in full prior to team formation. There is no payment plan for a reduced fee.
